Match Information

Our main aim is for a match that is both enjoyable, challenging and a good chance to socialise.

There will be four sessions, two on Saturday and Sunday. Shooters will be restricted to one firearm per session, total of four guns for the weekend. The match fee will be \$35 per firearm with a youth fee of \$5 per firearm.

Squads will be kept to a minimum, hopefully six to eight. This will mean that everyone will need to pitch in and help with RO duties, scoring (PractiScore on tablets), and painting. The squad RO will travel with the squad

Divisions and categories for both male and female competitors.

We will use **local rules**, where appropriate, to suit our range.

Match Registration: 8.15 - 9.00 on match day. Your firearm licence is required.

Match briefing at 9.00 immediately followed by eight stages of shooting.

Lunch will be supplied.

The afternoon session will commence after lunch at a time determined by the Match Director.

Prize giving will be immediately after the Sunday afternoon's shooting.

Please familiarise yourself with our club's firearm handling requirements. These are published on the front wall of the club house.



Stage Layout



S1 R1

Pendulum


