

Match Information

Our main aim is for a match that is both enjoyable, challenging and a good chance to socialise. There is plenty of room for self contained camping on the range.

There will be five sessions, two on Friday, two on Saturday and one on Sunday. Shooters will be restricted to one firearm per session, total of five guns for the match. If demand is high we may run another session on Saturday. The match fee will be \$35 per firearm with an under 16 fee of \$5 per firearm. The range will be available for practice on Thursday.

Squads will be kept to a minimum, hopefully six to seven. This will mean that everyone will need to pitch in and help with RO duties, scoring and painting. Where possible WPC members will help out. The squad RO will travel with the squad.

Divisions and categories for both male and female competitors.

We will use **local rules**, where appropriate, to suit our range.

Match Registration: 8.20 - 9.00 on match day. Your firearm licence is required.

Match briefing at 9.05 immediately followed by eight stages of shooting.

Lunch will be supplied.

The afternoon session will commence after lunch at a time determined by the Match Director.

Prize giving will be immediately after the Sunday afternoon's shooting.

Please familiarise yourself with our club's firearm handling requirements. These are published on the front wall of the club house.
